eventually named a captain, and earned a degree in history and sociology in 1997. Carmen currently represents NFL stars, NFL coaches, NFL executives, college basketball and football coaches, and sports broadcasters as one of the founders of the agency Athletes First in Laguna Hills, California. His role includes recruiting, training and negotiating on behalf of these professionals with their respective teams, universities, networks or digital entities.

Carmen was inducted into the Delaware Basketball Hall of Fame in 2015. His dedication to Tower Hill School has been stellar and steadfast, serving as a THS Trustee for the past nine years. 


